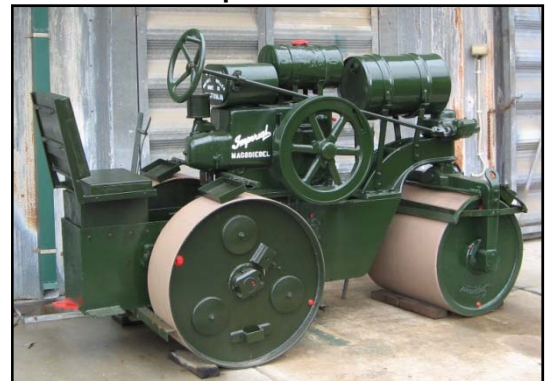
Recreating Weapons
